PRINCIPAL

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The academic year 2021-22 was the year NEP was introduced by the Government of Karnataka. To up skill the faculty members several workshops were conducted as part of the IQAC initiative on NEP. Faculty attended workshops conducted by the Bangalore University seeking knowledge and understanding of the new curriculum and syllabus under NEP 2020.

Outcome based education workshop was conducted by the OBE Cell to understand the concepts of Programme Outcome, Course Outcome and POCO Attainment.

The first Academic Council was conducted and the HoDs presented their department plans to the Management and IQAC.

Departments , Cells and committees were given institutional benchmarks in the academic council meeting.

The IQAC conducted a workshop by the IQAC Team of Kristu Jayanti College. The staff were oriented about their experiences of working towards achieving A++ Grade in their recent accreditation by NAAC. Initiatives were taken to revise the course plan/teaching plan of the faculty so as to focus more on student centric teaching and experiential teaching. Accordingly modifications were made in Linways Technology to facilitate entering of proper data for the classes conducted.

IQAC organized an online Alumni meet. Alumni expressed that they were looking forward to meet their teachers offline. As every year, the annual alumni meet was held in the month of August, since august is the month that celebrates friendship.

IQAC initiated Alumni interaction through several programmes like skill development, certificate courses etc.

Six days Virtual FDP on 'Learning and Teaching: Changes and Challenges for Faculty' was conducted in collaboration with Saint Francis de Sales College, Aalo, Arunachal Pradesh.

The College conducted many certificate courses and value added courses to meet the industry requirements and enhance knowledge of the students during the academic year.

Research Centre was sanctioned for PG - Commerce during the academic year.
